Learning at Home

Thank you for our continued support to help your child with their multiplication and division facts and home spellings.

<u>A reminder that</u> We expect children in Year Four to be completing <u>one hour</u> of homework each week. Children in Eagles are expected to complete the following Learning at Home on a weekly basis:

- Reading at home: daily (5 minutes each time)
- Home Maths book (multiplication and division facts): 3 times a week (5 minutes each time)
- MyMaths task (maximum 10 minutes)
- Home Spelling book: 3 times a week (5 minutes each time)
- Learning Log activities (optional)
