The children took an enjoyable train journey to travel back in time to the exciting world of wartime code breakers. They took the opportunity to look around the various exhibits and rooms of the museum, sit in a 1940s classroom, dress up in 1940's clothing and crack codes using the methods of the wartime code breakers and their own problem solving skills.

The highlight of the trip had to be the children were given the opportunity to touch a real Enigma machine and learn their secret agent code as well as finding out how many different combination the machine has.

What happens when there is a School or Pre-School Closure due to extreme bad weather / emergency

State of Schools Portal (SoS)

Central Bedfordshire Council has a 'State of Schools' portal, known as SOS. If there is a potential forecast of extreme weather or snow to come, you would be able to see if the school is open or closed if you have already registered.

- We would like to advise all parents who have not already done so to sign up to the system to receive alerts.
- If you have already registered please take a moment to familiarise yourself on how the system works.

Parents should visit: http://www.centralbedfordshire.gov.uk/webapps/sos to register, here you will also find access to a comprehensive user/ registration guide. We would like to promote this system to parents as we feel this is the best way to communicate school closures to everyone.

This system will allow us, the school, to login to automatically update the opening status of our school wherever we are. All parents that have signed up to the system will receive an immediate email alert to let them know the status of our school. This will also automatically update the Central Bedfordshire Council website at http://www.centralbedfordshire.gov.uk/webapps/sos. The radio stations will also receive email alerts and be able to monitor the website.

This will not replace our Text Alert system (**Groupcall**) - it is additional to. **Although we feel our text system** works extremely well this allows us to make sure everyone is informed of the School and Pre-School status should there be an emergency.
