#### Dear Parents,

Phonics:

We are continuing with Phase 5 in our phonics lessons this term in

preparation for phonics screening in the summer. I will be hosting information meeting on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> February (after school) to provide more information about the screening check, provide guidance about how you can support your child at home and answer any questions you may have. Hope to see you there!

#### Reading:

Please continue to read with your child, try to at least 3 times a week. 5 minutes is enough to encourage steady progress while developing a love of reading. Children will also benefit from listening to stories regularly. This helps them to build a wider vocabulary and develop a love of books. We are committed to reading with your child once a

week in school and your children will be doing guided reading sessions in small groups, Reading books will be changed on Fridays and Library books on Tuesdays.





## Spelling:

Weekly spellings will be set for your child on a Monday and we will complete a test in class on Friday. Please practice the spellings at home with your child using the 'look, say, cover, write, check' method outlined in their spelling books.
