Who are we?


- We are a small village school at the heart of the community.

In the afternoons Miss Meech who is our Pre-School room leader comes across to lead the continuous provision in Robins class.












Foundation Garden

- Our foundation children are very lucky to have a large outdoor area to themselves. We call this area 'The Garden'.
- The Garden houses a writing, reading and maths area for outdoor learning opportunities. We also have a large construction area, sand tray, role play area, water area, junk modelling station and a fantastic track which can be used for obstacle courses, races and balance bikes.












Our Learning Journey

- Throughout the whole school we follow a topic based creative curriculum where each class can immerse themselves within a topic for a term.
- Children are encouraged to explore, question, discuss and take ownership of their learning journey, striving to do better and to understand what they need to learn next in order to achieve their full potential.
- Wherever possible we will also strive to use our local community to strengthen our curriculum learning, and allowing visitors into school to inspire our pupils.



Children's Mental Health and Wellbeing

- At Houghton Conquest Lower School we follow a Growth Mindset approach to teaching and learning which promotes resilience, perseverance and creates confident and independent problem solvers.
- We promote children's positive mental health and wellbeing through a variety of ways including mindfulness assemblies, active assemblies, regular brain breaks / active breaks scheduled into the school day and a positive behaviour policy.
- We celebrate individual achievements through team points, golden tickets and weekly certificates awarded in our Celebration Assembly.
- We also offer intervention groups and 1:1 sessions to children who we feel would benefit from additional emotional support.
- We have implemented our Zones of Regulation across the school. We are very proud that our children feel comfortable and confident in using these zones to talk about how they are feeling and to find ways to regulate their emotions.

Extra Curricular Activities

- We provide wrap around care in the form of Home from Home club which operates between 8am – 8:50am and from 3:15pm – 5:30pm daily. They run activities including art and crafts, games activities, done and dusted homework support, cinema mornings and many more.
- We provide a range of enhanced curricular activities that will enrich your child's experience. These vary from year to year but can include Choir, Musical Instruments including Guitar, Piano & Cello, Football, Lace Club, Music, Dance & Drama, and Netball. Some of these groups run at lunchtimes and some are after school.



Our Wonderful 'Friends'

- 'Friends of Houghton Conquest Lower School' are our PTA (Parent Teacher Association) and are an incredible group!
- Fundraising events have included: The Christmas Fayre, World Book Day events, school discos, Movie Night, bake sales, Mother's Day and Father's Day gift making, Easter egg hunt and creating Harvest Festival boxes for the local community.
- In recent years funds have provided:
- A wooden pirate ship for the playground
- iPads for each class and Pre-School
- A new pond and welly rack in the Lower School
- A sunshade and chalkboard wall in Pre-School
- In school workshops
- The annual Christmas pantomime




Application Process

- ▶ The deadline for admissions is 15th January 2021

- You accept/ decline your place
- You will be invited to our 'New Intake Meeting' in June/July which begins the transition process from your current nursery/ pre-school.
