


# Eagles Newsletter

# <u>Homework</u>

Children in Eagles are expected to complete the following Learning at Home on a weekly basis:

• **Reading** at home: daily (5 minutes each time)

- TT Rockstars: 3 times a week (5 minutes each time)
- Home Spellings: 3 times a week (5 minutes each time) - The test will be on Friday. New spellings will be sent out on Monday.

# <u>Reading</u>

Children earn a sticker towards a reading reward every time they read three or more times per week at home. I would encourage you to help the progression of your child's reading by asking them questions about the book regularly, examples of questions can be found in your child's reading record.

# <u>PSHE</u>

As part of the national curriculum and the PSHE association guide the learning opportunities this term will be on the topic 'changes' including looking at how the body changes during puberty. These topics will of course be taught with sensitivity; if you have any questions or concerns about what is going to be covered, please do not hesitate to ask.

# School Uniform

Please ensure that your child has appropriate school PE kit and uniform. Please have a look at our website for details of the essential items for your child's uniform. **Sun screen should be applie before cildren come to scool**. As the weather improves, **a hat** will be essential to protect your child from the sun at break and lunch time.

# Drinks and Healthy snacks

The children will be making use of the outside areas and as the weather warms, they will need to ensure that they have their own <u>labelled bottle of water</u> in school each day (and remind your child to return it home regularly for cleaning).

Please note, children are not allowed juice or flavoured water in school (except in their packed lunch).

# Star of the week

Each fortnight, teachers choose a child from their class whom they feel has shone to receive the 'Star of the Week' Teacher's Award. The child receives a certificate in our Celebration Assembly and an announcement in the newsletter soon after. On alternate weeks our Teaching Assistants decide which child has been their 'Star of the Week'.
