Equipment

School Uniform – Now that shops have reopened, please ensure your child has the correct school uniform and check all items of clothing are clearly labelled with your child's name. The children will be making use of the outside areas and require a waterproof coat/jacket, and sun hat.

PE Kit - This term Doves will have P.E on a Friday. Please ensure your child arrives wearing the appropriate PE kit. Your child may also wear tracksuit bottoms to cover their legs and their school jumper.

Forest School – This term the children in the Doves class will have the opportunity to attend forest school. Your child must come into school with wellies, spare clothes and (weather dependent) waterproofs / sun hats.



Attendance

Doves' attendance currently sits at **94.96%**. We have all worked tremendously hard to build our class attendance during the school year, so we should be incredibly proud of ourselves!

Remember it is very important to attend school every day and be present for the registration period.

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Phonics:

Over the course of the academic year Doves have worked incredibly hard to learn all our phase 5 sounds. This half term we will be revising our sounds and preparing for our phonics screening check. Although the national phonics screening check has been postponed, we will still be undertaking one for internal use and to check progress. If your child wants to do more than this, please use no more than the double page with the topic label. Just a reminder these are not compulsory, however they do play a huge part in developing the children's confidence, fine motor and communication and language skills.
