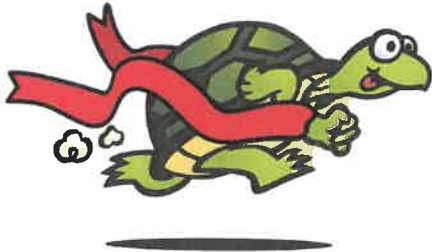
## Values Day – Friday, 9<sup>th</sup> July
