Raffle tickets are still available from either the Friends or from the school office.

# Year 3 & 4 singing at the opening of the Christmas Tree Festival: Friday, 10<sup>th</sup> December at 6pm

This annual event takes place at All Saints Church, Houghton Conquest and our year 3 and 4 children will, once again, be singing a couple of songs to open the Festival.

It is hope that all our year 3 and 4 children will be able to meet Mr Hetherington and Mr Birchall at the church at 5.50pm (*parents will need to stay during the event*). Remember to wrap up warm with a coat and hat and perhaps your festive colour/style jumper as we will be round the Christmas tree which is outside.





Whilst at the church take the opportunity to go inside and see the many decorated Christmas Trees including ones decorated by the school and pre-school children. The church will be serving hot chocolate, mulled wine and savoury nibbles – all welcome.

### School Christmas Lunch: Wednesday, 15<sup>th</sup> December

We are having our Christmas Lunch on Wednesday, 15<sup>th</sup> December. You will find your child's green order form in their book bag – please ensure this is returned to school by **Friday, 3<sup>rd</sup> December**. Please can we ask that <u>everyone</u> returns the form, even if your child is going to have a packed lunch; this ensures we do not inadvertently miss anyone out.

To help get us all in the festive mood children can come to school in a festive colour/style jumper on this day.

All pre-school children in session who would usually have a hot school dinner on this day will have a hot Christmas dinner automatically on this day; please ensure you return your form to pre-school by the 3<sup>rd</sup> December.















### Our Christmas Nativity: Tuesday, 14th December at 2.30pm

This year all the children (including pre-school) will be taking part in our Christmas Nativity and the children are busy rehearsing.

In order to comply with Public Heath guidance and our risk assessment the following will apply:-

- The event will take place outside on the school playground
- We will be limiting tickets to 2 adults per family (these will be sent home in due course).
- We ask that you undertake a lateral flow COVID test before attending the event. Please do not attend if you are isolating or have any COVID symptoms.

We do hope that you will be able to join us; remember to wrap up warm and bring a chair if you like.

(If the weather is forecast to be bad on Tuesday, 14<sup>th</sup> December we will hold the event on Thursday, 16<sup>th</sup> December – parents will be notified by text on the morning of the 14<sup>th</sup> December to confirm or otherwise when the event will be taking place).

## Pantomime (Friends event): Friday, 17<sup>th</sup> December (am)

This is an annual event organised by the Friends for all children in the school and pre-school and will once again be held in the Village Hall. The children will arrive in school as normal and we will walk over to the village hall once registration has taken place.

They will then be sorted by a small group of staff and/or year 4 children and delivered to the classrooms to bring home. Unfortunately we are unable to accept any cards before or after this date.

To ensure we can deliver all the cards please make sure that all cards have the recipient's class name or year group on the front and include, where possible, their full name.
