## Homework

Children in Eagles are expected to complete the following Learning at Home on a weekly basis:

- Home Multiplications: at least once a week
- Reading at home: daily (5 minutes each time)
- Times Table Rockstars: 3 times a week (5 minutes each time)
- Home Spelling book: 3 times a week (5 minutes each time)
- Learning Log activities (optional)

# Reading

Children earn a sticker towards a reading reward every time they read three or more times per week at home. I would encourage you to help the progression of your child's reading by asking them questions about the book regularly, examples of questions can be found in your child's reading record.

## Multiplication Times Table Check

The purpose of the check is to determine whether your child can fluently recall their times tables up to 12. Each child is required to complete the check between 6<sup>th</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> July. It is an on-screen check consisting of 25 times table questions. They will then have 6 seconds to answer each question. Please encourage your child to complete their weekly homework on TTRockstars in preparation for the check.

## School Uniform

Please ensure that your child has appropriate school PE kit and uniform. Please have a look at our website for details of the essential items for your child's uniform. Sun screen should be applied before children come to school. As the weather improves, a hat will be essential to protect your child from the sun at break and lunch time.

### Drinks and Healthy snacks

The children will be making use of the outside areas and as the weather warms, they will need to ensure that they have their own <u>labelled bottle of water</u> in school each day (and remind your child to return it regularly for cleaning).

Please note, children are not allowed juice or flavoured water in school (except for packed lunch).

## Star of the week

Each fortnight, teachers choose a child from their class whom they feel has shone to receive the 'Star of the Week' Teacher's Award. The child receives a certificate in our Celebration Assembly and an announcement in the newsletter soon after. On alternate weeks our Teaching Assistants decide which child has been their 'Star of the Week'.
