Structure for Academic Year 2022/2023 & Step-up-day Arrangements

As we approach the end of this academic year, we would like to give a full overview of what to expect when we return to school in September, as well as clarify details for our 'step-up day' on the **6th July.**

Teaching Structure for Academic Year 2022/2023

Robins (Reception): Mrs Waby will be teaching the Foundation class.

Doves (Year 1): Mrs Rolfe will be teaching Year 1.

Owls (Year 2): Miss Crowhurst and Mrs Blake will be teaching Year 2. Miss Crowhurst will be teaching in Owls for three days each week with Mrs Blake teaching the other two.

Hawks (Year 3): Mr Birchall will be teaching our Year 3 class.

Eagles (Year 4): Mr Hetherington will be teaching the Year 4 class.

In order to support the transition to next year we are holding our '**Step Up Day**' on **Wednesday** 6th July – see below for more details.

To allow me to concentrate on headteacher duties I will not be having responsibility for a class but I will still have opportunities to teach across the school.

Step Up Day Arrangements
