





We create our own paintings of daffodils.</p> </div> <div>  <p>Our World - We look at Ireland, Wales and India on the globe and discuss the contrasting environments through learning about St Patricks Day, St David's Day and the celebration of Holi.</p> </div> <p>Our environment - We look at the environment around us and discuss the importance of recycling. We discuss the properties of materials and sort objects into recycling piles.</p> <p>Earth - We introduce continents and the 5 oceans on Earth to see where dinosaurs may have lived.</p> <div>  <p>Dinosaur Hunt - We go on a dinosaur hunt around our school.
