Geography

European Countries

To understand geographical similarities and differences through the study of human and physical geography of a region of the United Kingdom, a region in a European country. To use maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping to locate countries and describe features studied. To locate the world's countries, using maps to focus on Europe. To describe and understand key aspects of human geography, including: types of settlement and land use, economic activity including trade links, and the distribution of natural resources including energy, food, minerals and water.

Science

Electricity

Identify the dangers associated with electricity in the home. Construct a simple circuit, identifying the basic parts to label a diagram.

Predict if different 'circuit' layouts will light a bulb, and then test predictions.

Open and close a circuit with a switch and predict and test which other materials could be used to conduct electricity. Record findings and draw conclusions about materials used to make electrical circuits, and materials used to keep us safe from electrical circuits.

Make a circuit with a buzzer and a switch and record the circuit in a labelled diagram.



Sound

Sound investigating which materials are best for sound proofing.

Discovering how vibrations cause sounds and how vibrations link to the volume of sound made, Considering the patterns between objects and their pitch.
