Forest School

Home Spellings

Your child will bring home a 'Home Spellings' book which is to be completed three times per week. Please help your child follow our Look, Cover, Write, Check strategy.

Please ensure your child's spelling book is in school every Friday. Spellings will be set on a Monday and will be collected in on a Friday



Phonics

Following on from the Phonics Information Breakfast event, your child will bring home one piece of phonics home learning a week. Each piece of work will focus on one or two key sound to practice as we prepare for our phonics screening. This will be sent home on a Friday and does not need to be returned but if the children would like to share their work they can, of course, bring them in.



Reading

Reading books will be checked daily and changed every Friday with their new book that has been matched to their phonetic ability. <u>Please ensure your child has</u> <u>their book in school every day</u>.

I would encourage you to help the progression of your child's reading by asking them questions about the book regularly; examples of questions can be found in your child's reading record.

<u>Learning Logs</u>

Withing your Learning Log, we are happy with just a couple of drawings/photographs with a caption or two will be sufficient. If your child wants to do more than this, please use no more than the double page with the topic label. We aren't judging the best handwriting or spelling; we are looking for imaginative ideas expressed by the children through pictures and words. We hope you will enjoy spending time with your child talking about each learning log topic with your child. Just a reminder these are not compulsory, however they do play a huge part in developing the children's confidence, fine motor and communication and language skills.

Phonics

During Autumn term Doves Class have worked very hard to begin learning our phase 5 phonics sounds. This term we will finish learning the sounds and begin revising them and preparing for our phonics screening check.

The phonics screening check is a national requirement for all year 1 children.
