Children in Eagles are expected to complete the following Learning at Home on a weekly basis:

- Reading at home: daily (5 minutes each time)
- Times Table Rockstars: 3 times a week
 (5 minutes each time)
- Home Spelling book: 3 times a week (5 minutes each time)
- Learning Log activities (optional)

Reading

Children earn a sticker towards a reading reward every time they read three or more times per week at home. I would encourage you to help the progression of your child's reading by asking them questions about the book regularly, examples of questions can be found in your child's reading record.

Multiplication Times Table Check

The purpose of the check is to determine whether your child can fluently recall their times tables up to 12. Each child is required to complete the check between **Monday 2nd June**. Friday 13th **June**. It is an on-screen check consisting of 25 times table questions. They will then have 6 seconds to answer each question. Please encourage your child to complete their weekly homework on TTRockstars in preparation for the check.

School Uniform

Please ensure that your child has appropriate school PE kit and uniform. Please have a look at our website for details of the essential items for your child's uniform. Sun screen should be applie before cildren come to scool. As the weather improves, a hat will be essential to protect your child from the sun at break and lunch time.
