

Literacy:

We will develop our reading and writing skills through setting descriptions, diary writing and poetry linked to the Great Fire of London. We will focus on using descriptive language, sequencing events, and expressing ideas clearly in different forms of writing.

Maths:

We will develop our understanding of numbers to 20 and then extend this to numbers to 50. We will learn to add and subtract within 20, using practical resources and pictorial methods. We will also explore measurement, comparing and measuring length and height, as well as mass and capacity, using appropriate language and tools.

Science:

We will learn about different materials and their properties, exploring how materials are used for different purposes. We will also learn how to care for our planet by understanding how our choices affect the environment. We will observe and describe seasonal changes, noticing how the weather, plants and animals change throughout the year.

Computing:

We will develop our keyboard and mouse skills by designing rockets and using drawing software. We will create digital materials lists and learn how to record and organise data. We will also explore commands, instructions and errors by programming and controlling a Bee-Bot.

Music:

We will explore 2 songs In the Groove and Round and Round.

Art / DT:

We will be learning how Tudor houses were designed and built. We will design, make and evaluate our own Tudor house models, using different materials and tools safely. In Art we will explore Arctic artwork, looking at how artists use colour, texture and pattern to show cold environments and wildlife. We will experiment with different art techniques to create our own Arctic-inspired artwork.
